

## **GALACTIC ADVENTURE CONTEST RULES**

**GALACTIC ADVENTURE CONTEST** (THE “**CONTEST**”) WILL BE CONDUCTED IN CANADA ONLY (EXCLUDING QUÉBEC) AND SHALL BE CONSTRUED AND EVALUATED ACCORDING TO APPLICABLE CANADIAN LAW. NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY. PARTICIPANTS MUST BE OF THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THEIR PROVINCE OR TERRITORY OF RESIDENCE OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE CONTEST RULES (THE “**CONTEST RULES**”).

### **1. ELIGIBILITY.**

1.1 To be eligible for this Contest, an individual must:

- (a) be a legal resident of Canada (excluding the province of Québec);
- (b) be of the age of majority in his/her province or territory of residence or older at the time of entry; and
- (c) be legally able to travel to the United States of America and have any and all necessary documentation that may be required for presentation to Canadian and/or International customs and airport personnel.

1.2 The following people are not eligible to enter the Contest:

- (a) Employees of Corus Sales Inc. and its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (collectively “**Corus Sales**”);
- (b) Employees of Corus Radio Inc. and its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (collectively “**Corus Radio**”; together with Corus Sales, “**Corus**”);
- (c) Employees of The Walt Disney Company (Canada) Ltd. and its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (collectively, the “**Prize Provider**”), and their respective advertising, promotion and web design agencies;
- (d) Any person who has been confirmed as a winner of two (2) Corus administered contests within six (6) months preceding the Contest start date indicated below; and
- (e) The household and immediate family members of any of the parties listed in Section (a) to (d) above.

1.3 Corus shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to Corus for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. Corus reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant should such an entrant at any stage supply information that does not meet these requirements.

2. **CONTEST PERIOD.** The Contest begins at 10:00a.m. Eastern Time (“**ET**”) on May 27, 2019 and ends at 11:59p.m. ET on August 30, 2019 (the "**Contest Period**") after which time the Contest will be closed and no further entries shall be accepted.

### 3. HOW TO ENTER.

3.1 There is no purchase necessary to enter the Contest. Enter online, by completing and submitting the entry form located at [www.disneychannel.ca](http://www.disneychannel.ca) (the “**Contest Microsite**”).

3.2 Limit of one (1) entry per person, per 24-hour period. In the case of multiple entries in a 24-hour period, only the first eligible entry will be considered.

3.3 All entries, become the sole property of Corus and will not be returned for any reason. Entries must be received no later than the end of the Contest Period. Entries will be declared invalid if they are late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, irregular, mutilated, forged, garbled or mechanically or electronically reproduced. Unless otherwise set out herein, no communication or correspondence will be exchanged with entrants except with those selected as a potential winner.

3.4 Entries received online shall be deemed to be submitted by the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the entry. For the purpose of the Contest Rules, “authorized account holder” of an e-mail address is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, on-line service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address. Any entrant may be required to provide Corus with proof that they are the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with their entry.

### 4. PRIZES.

4.1 There are three (3) prizes (collectively the “**Prizes**” each, a “**Prize**”) available to be won by the Prize winners (collectively the “**Winners**”, each a “**Winner**”) consisting of each Winner’s choice of:

(a) A vacation for four (4) to *Disneyland* Resort in California for five (5) days’ and four (4) nights’ (the “**California Vacation**”) for the Winner and three (3) guests (each a “**Guest**” and collectively, the “**Guests**”); or

(b) A vacation for four (4) to *Walt Disney World* Resort in Florida for six (6) days’ and five (5) nights’ (the “**Florida Vacation**”) for the Winner and three (3) Guests.

4.2 The California Vacation shall include:

(a) Up to four (4) round trip coach airfares for the Winner and his/her Guests between a major Canadian International airport closest to the Winner’s residence and a Southern California airport (the “**California Airport**”), as determined by the Prize Provider in its sole discretion;

(b) Up to four (4) round trip ground transfers for the Winner and his/her Guests between the California Airport and *Disneyland* Resort, as determined by the Prize Provider in its sole discretion;

(c) Four (4) consecutive nights’ hotel accommodations at *Disneyland* Resort in a standard room, at a hotel to be selected by the Prize Provider in its sole discretion, for the Winner and

Guests, based on quadruple occupancy unless otherwise indicated;

- (d) Up to four (4) 5-Day *Disneyland Resort Park Hopper* Tickets for use by the Winner and his/her Guests at the *Disneyland Resort*;
- (e) One (1) Disney Gift Card with a value of six hundred U.S. dollars (USD\$600) for the Winner (subject to restrictions); and
- (f) Services of one (1) Disney VIP Tour Guide for eight (8) hours on one (1) day during the California Vacation.

4.3 The Florida Vacation shall include:

- (a) Up to four (4) round trip coach airfares for the Winner and Guests between a major Canadian International airport closest to the Winner's residence and Orlando International Airport (the "**Florida Airport**"), as determined by the Prize Provider;
- (b) Up to four (4) round trip ground transfers for the Winner and his/her Guests between the Florida Airport and *Walt Disney World Resort*, as determined by the Prize Provider in its sole discretion;
- (c) Five (5) consecutive nights' hotel accommodations at *Walt Disney World Resort* in a standard room, at a hotel to be selected by the Prize Provider in its sole discretion, for the Winner and his/her Guests, based on quadruple occupancy unless otherwise indicated;
- (d) Up to four (4) 6-Day *Walt Disney World* Theme Park Tickets with *Park Hopper Plus* Option;
- (e) One (1) Disney Gift Card with a value of six hundred U.S. dollars (USD\$600) for the Winner (subject to restrictions); and
- (f) Services of one (1) Disney VIP Tour Guide for eight (8) hours on one (1) day during the Florida Vacation.

4.4 The California Vacation has an approximate value of nine thousand six hundred U.S. dollars (USD\$9,600). Actual value of the California Vacation will depend on departure city, seasonal fluctuations of airfare and fluctuations in currency exchange rates, and the number of Guests.

4.5 The Florida Vacation has an approximate value of eleven thousand five hundred and fifty-one U.S. dollars (USD\$11,551). Actual value of the Florida Vacation will depend on departure city, seasonal fluctuations of airfare and fluctuations in currency exchange rates, and the number of Guests.

4.6 Winners are not entitled to monetary difference between actual Prize value and stated approximate Prize value, if any.

4.7 Corus and/or Corus' representatives will contact the Winner to coordinate the provision of the Prizes within five (5) days once such Winners have been successfully contacted and notified of his/her Prize and fulfilled the requirements set out herein.

## 5. PRIZE CONDITIONS.

- 5.1 All bookings and/or reservations are subject to hotel, room, and flight availability at time of booking through a travel agent at least forty-five (45) days prior to arrival. Block-out dates may apply. Winners and Guests must be available to travel and participate in the Prizes between January 1, 2020 and July 1, 2020, and must be able to travel together on the same itinerary. No extensions will be granted. Air transportation must be round-trip from/to the same departure Airport to the California Airport or Florida Airport, as the case may be. Certain travel and lodging restrictions apply including airline carrier's regulations and conditions. Airline tickets are non-refundable, non-transferable, and are not valid for upgrades. Corus and the Prize Provider are not liable for any expenses incurred as a consequence of flight cancellation/delay. Should Winners and/or Guests be unable to travel/participate on the dates and times designated herein by Corus, the Prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner.
- 5.2 The terms by which the Disney Gift Card may be redeemed are governed by the Prize Provider as described on the website located at:  
<https://www.disneygiftcard.com/ProductInformation/WhereToUse>. Corus is not responsible for administering or ensuring compliance with the terms and conditions relating to the gift card.
- 5.3 Winners and Guests will be responsible for transportation to and from originating airport, travel and medical insurance, travel documentation, applicable airport departure fees and taxes, airport parking fees, airport improvement fees or similar charges, bag check fees, tips and gratuities, nursery charges (if applicable), meals, hotel room service, laundry service, spa treatments, beverages, parking, local and long distance telephone calls, merchandise and souvenirs, incidental expenses and any other expense not explicitly included in the Prizes. Winners may be required to present a valid major credit card upon check-in at *Disneyland Resort* or *Walt Disney World Resort* to cover any expenses over and above the standard room charge.
- 5.4 Guests must: (i) be legally able to travel to the United States; (ii) have any and all necessary documentation as may be required for presentation to Canadian and/or International customs and airport personnel; and (iii) comply with the Contest Rules and sign and return the Release (described below).
- 5.5 The parent or guardian of any minor not travelling with a parent or guardian must appoint an adult to have custody and control over their minor and to contract on their behalf in connection with the California Vacation or the Florida Vacation. An appointment form will be included in the document package and must be signed by parent or legal guardian prior to the travel date.
- 5.6 Prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be sold, traded, transferred, refunded, commissioned, assigned, substituted or redeemed for cash or rescheduled to dates other than as set forth above, except at the sole discretion of Corus and the Prize Provider. If a Winner chooses to bring less than the allotted number of Guests, the Prize will be awarded in increments suitable for the actual number of participants with no substitute Prize or compensation provided to the Winner. Any unused, unclaimed or declined portion of any Prize will be forfeited, have no cash value, and Corus and the Prize Provider shall have no obligation to provide either an alternative or value-in-kind. Any damaged, lost or stolen Theme Park Tickets, Gift Cards or travel vouchers will not be replaced. Corus and the Prize Provider reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if the Prize (or any portion thereof) cannot be awarded for any reason. Theme Park attractions and entertainment may be seasonal and subject to changes without notice. Terms and conditions as set forth herein and on the Theme Park Tickets and vouchers shall apply. The capacity for *Disneyland Park*, *Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge* and its

experiences are limited. Access to the park, land and experiences may be restricted or unavailable depending on guest demand and other factors. *Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge* will not be available during Extra Magic Hour or Magic Morning at *Disneyland Park*. Disney FASTPASS services and Disney MaxPass are unavailable for attractions in *Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge*. *Star Wars: Rise of the Resistance* will not be available at the opening of *Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge* and will open later in 2019. The capacity for Disney's *Hollywood Studios*, *Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge* and its experiences are limited. Access to Disney's *Hollywood Studios*, the land and experiences may be restricted or unavailable depending on guest demand and other factors. Disney FastPass+ service is unavailable for the attractions in *Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge*. *Star Wars: Rise of the Resistance* will not be available at the opening of *Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge* and will open later in 2019. Winner may not charge any Guest for participating in a Prize.

- 5.7 Shipped Prizes shall not be insured and neither Corus nor the Prize Provider shall not assume any liability for lost, damaged or misdirected Prizes.
- 5.8 Winner and/or any Guest without proper citizenship documentation will be denied boarding. It is the Winner and Guests' responsibility to check with their travel agent, government agencies, embassies or consulates prior to their vacation to ensure that they have proper citizenship documentation. Guests of all ages are strongly encouraged to obtain passports.
- 5.9 All disputes arising out of or relating to the California Vacation provided by Prize Provider shall be resolved by applying the law of California, without regard to conflict of law rules, and shall be solely and exclusively brought in state or in federal courts within Orange County, California. All disputes arising out of or relating to the Florida Vacation provided by Prize Provider shall be resolved by applying the law of Florida, without regard to conflict of law rules, and shall be solely and exclusively brought in state or in federal courts within Orange County, Florida. All claims relating to a Prize shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form or class action and all such claims shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, but in no event to include any attorneys' fees.

## **6. WINNER SELECTION.**

- 6.1 Three (3) Winners shall be selected as follows:
  - (a) On or about September 2, 2019 in Toronto, Ontario, three (3) entrants will be selected by a random draw from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. Each entrant shall be eligible to win only one (1) Prize. The odds of being selected as a potential winner are dependent upon the number of eligible entries received by Corus. Before being declared a Winner, each selected entrant shall be required to correctly answer, without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question to be administered during a pre-arranged telephone call or by e-mail, to comply with the Contest Rules and to sign and return the Release (described below).
  - (b) EACH SELECTED ENTRANT WILL BE NOTIFIED BY E-MAIL NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 6, 2019 AT 5:00 P.M. AND MUST RESPOND WITHIN FIVE (5) BUSINESS DAYS OF NOTIFICATION. Upon notification, the selected entrant must respond by telephone or e-mail (as specified in the notification) to the contact number or e-mail address provided no later than the indicated deadline set out in the Contest Rules and/or the notification. If the selected entrant does not respond accordingly, he/she will be disqualified and will not receive a Prize and another entrant may be selected in Corus'

sole discretion until such time as an entrant satisfies the terms set out herein. Corus is not responsible for the failure for any reason whatsoever of a selected entrant to receive notification or for Corus to receive a selected entrant's response.

- (c) If, as a result of an error relating to the entry process, drawing or any other aspect of the Contest, there are more selected entrants than contemplated in these Contest Rules, there will be a random draw amongst all eligible Prize claimants after the Contest's closing date to award the correct number of Prizes.

7. **RELEASE.** Potential Winners and Guests will be required to execute a legal agreement and release (“**Release**”) that confirms each potential Winner's and Guest's: (i) eligibility for the Contest and compliance with these Contest Rules; (ii) acceptance of the Prize as offered; (iii) release of each of Corus, Prize Provider, and each of their respective employees, directors, officers, suppliers, agents, sponsors, administrators, licensees, representatives, advertising, media buying and promotional agencies (collectively, the “**Releasees**”) from any and all liability for any loss, harm, damages, cost or expense arising out of participation in the Contest, participation in any Contest-related activity or the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize, including but not limited to costs, injuries, losses related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation, or portrayal in a false light, or from any and all claims of third parties arising therefrom; and (iv) grant to Corus of the unrestricted right, in Corus' collective or individual discretion, to produce, reproduce, display, publish, convert, post, serve, broadcast, exhibit, distribute, adapt and otherwise use or re-use the Winner's and Guest's name, statements, image, likeness, voice and biography, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, in connection with the Contest and the promotion and exploitation thereof. The executed Release must be returned within two (2) business days of the date indicated on the accompanying letter of notification or the verification as a Winner or the selected entrant will be disqualified and the Prize forfeited.
8. **INDEMNIFICATION BY ENTRANT.** By entering the Contest, each entrant releases, indemnifies and holds Releasees harmless from any and all liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person, including personal injury, death, or property damage, resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from (a) their participation in the Contest or any Contest-related activity; (b) the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize; or (c) any breach of the Contest Rules. Each entrant agrees to fully indemnify the Releasees from any and all claims made by third parties relating to the entrant's participation in the Contest, without limitation.
9. **LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.** Corus assumes no responsibility or liability for lost, late, unintelligible/illegible, falsified, damaged, misdirected or incomplete entries, notifications, responses, replies or any Release, or for any computer, online, software, telephone, hardware or technical malfunctions that may occur, including but not limited to malfunctions that may affect the transmission or non-transmission of an entry. Corus is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by website users or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest. Corus assumes no responsibility or liability in the event that the Contest cannot be conducted as planned for any reason, including reasons beyond the control of Corus, such as infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or corruption of the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Contest and/or the Contest Microsite.
10. **CONDUCT.** By participating in the Contest, each entrant is deemed to have executed and agrees to be bound by the Contest Rules, which will be posted at the Contest Microsite and made available throughout the Contest Period. Each entrant further agrees to be bound by the decisions of Corus, which shall be final and binding in all respects. Corus reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant

found to be: (a) violating the Contest Rules; (b) tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Contest and/or the Contest Microsite or any related promotional website; (c) violating the terms of service, conditions of use and/or general rules or guidelines of any Corus property or service; and/or (d) acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass Corus or any other person. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE THE CONTEST MICROSITE OR ANY RELATED WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST MAY BE A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS. SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, CORUS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK REMEDIES AND DAMAGES TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CRIMINAL PROSECUTION. Winners and Guests must at all times behave appropriately when taking part in the Prize and observe the Contest Rules and any other rules or regulations in force at *Disneyland* Resort, *Walt Disney World* Resort and/or any other Prize-related locations. The Parties reserve the right to remove from *Disneyland* Resort, *Walt Disney World* Resort and/or any other Prize-related locations, any Winner and/or Guest who breaks such rules and/or fails to behave appropriately and to disqualify such Winner and/or Guest. Any disqualified Winner and/or Guest will forfeit any unawarded elements of the Prize.

## **11. PRIVACY / USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION.**

11.1 By participating in the Contest, each entrant: (i) grants to Corus and/or the Prize Provider the right to use his/her name, mailing address, age of majority confirmation, telephone number and e-mail address (collectively the “**Personal Information**”) for the purpose of administering the Contest, including but not limited to contacting and announcing the Winners and coordinating the provision of the Prizes; (ii) grants to Corus the right to use his/her Personal Information for publicity and promotional purposes relating to the Contest, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, without further compensation unless prohibited by law; and (iii) acknowledges that Corus and/or the Prize Provider may disclose his/her Personal Information to third-party agents and service providers of any Corus and/or the Prize Provider in connection with any of the activities listed in (i) and (ii) above.

11.2 By opting-in online you consent to Corus’ and any of its corporate affiliate’s use of your Personal Information to contact you via email to receive newsletters about relevant channel and show promotions. Corus will use the entrant’s Personal Information only for identified purposes, and protect the entrant’s Personal Information in a manner that is consistent with Corus’ Privacy Policy at: <http://www.disneychannel.ca/privacy>.

**12. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY.** All intellectual property, including but not limited to trade-marks, trade names, logos, designs, promotional materials, web pages, source code, drawings, illustrations, slogans and representations, is owned by Corus and/or the Prize Supplier and/or their affiliates. All rights are reserved. Unauthorized copying or use of any copyrighted material or intellectual property without the express written consent of its owner is strictly prohibited.

**13. TERMINATION.** Corus reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to terminate the Contest, in whole or in part, and/or modify, amend or suspend the Contest, and/or the Contest Rules in any way, at any time, for any reason without prior notice.

- 14. LAW.** These are the official Contest Rules. The Contest is subject to applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. The Contest Rules are subject to change without notice in order to comply with any applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws or the policy of any other entity having jurisdiction over Corus. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Contest Rules or the rights and obligations as between the entrant and Corus in connection with the Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of Ontario without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other jurisdiction's laws
- 15. DISCREPANCY.** In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules and disclosures or other statements contained in any Contest-related materials, including but not limited to the Contest entry form, or point of sale, television, print or online advertising, the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules shall prevail, govern and control.
- 16. SOCIAL MEDIA.** This Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by any social media platforms on which the Contest may have been promoted and/or publicized, including but not limited to Facebook and/or Twitter. Any personal information provided in connection with the Contest is being provided to Corus and any questions, comments or complaints regarding the Contest must be directed to Corus.
