

DISNEY CHANNEL'S MAGICAL VACATION CONTEST RULES

THE DISNEY CHANNEL'S MAGICAL VACATION CONTEST (THE "**CONTEST**") WILL BE CONDUCTED IN CANADA ONLY (EXCLUDING QUÉBEC) AND SHALL BE CONSTRUED AND EVALUATED ACCORDING TO APPLICABLE CANADIAN LAW. NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY. ENTRANTS MUST BE OF THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THEIR PROVINCE OR TERRITORY OF RESIDENCE OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE CONTEST RULES (THE "**CONTEST RULES**").

1. ELIGIBILITY.

1.1 To be eligible for this Contest, an individual must:

- (a) be a legal resident of Canada (excluding the province of Québec);
- (b) be of the age of majority in their province or territory of residence or older at the time of entry; and
- (c) be legally able to travel to the United States of America and have any and all necessary documentation that may be required for presentation to Canadian and/or International customs and airport personnel.

1.2 The following people are not eligible to enter the Contest:

- (a) Employees of Corus Sales Inc., its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (collectively "**Corus**");
- (b) Employees of The Walt Disney Company (Canada) Ltd., its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (collectively, "**Prize Provider**"), and their respective advertising, promotion and web design agencies;
- (c) Any person who has been confirmed as a winner of two (2) Corus administered contests within six (6) months preceding the Contest start date indicated below; and
- (d) The household and immediate family members of any of the parties listed in Section (a) to (c).

1.3 Corus shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to Corus for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. Corus reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant should such an entrant at any stage supply information that does not meet these requirements.

2. **CONTEST PERIOD.** The Contest begins at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Time ("**ET**") on June 28, 2021 and ends at 11:59 p.m. ET on July 25, 2021 (the "**Contest Period**") after which time the Contest will be closed and no further entries shall be accepted.

3. HOW TO ENTER.

- 3.1 There is no purchase necessary to enter the Contest. To enter, complete and submit the entry form located at <https://www.disneychannel.ca/magical-vacation> (the “**Contest Microsite**”). No entries will be accepted by any other means.
- 3.2 Limit of one (1) entry per person, per 24-hour period. In the case of multiple entries in a 24-hour period, only the first eligible entry will be considered.
- 3.3 All entries become the sole property of Corus and will not be returned for any reason. Entries must be received no later than the end of the Contest Period. Entries will be declared invalid if they are late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, irregular, mutilated, forged, garbled or mechanically or electronically reproduced. Unless otherwise set out herein, no communication or correspondence will be exchanged with entrants except with those selected as a potential winner.
- 3.4 Entries received online shall be deemed to be submitted by the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the entry. For the purpose of the Contest Rules, “authorized account holder” of an e-mail address is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, on-line service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address. Any entrant may be required to provide Corus with proof that they are the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with their entry.

4. PRIZE.

- 4.1 There is one (1) prize (the “**Prize**”) available to be won by the Prize winner (“**Winner**”) consisting of a vacation for four (4) to *Walt Disney World* Resort in Florida for six (6) days and five (5) nights for the Winner and three (3) guests (each a “**Guest**” and collectively, the “**Guests**”) which shall include the following:
 - (a) Up to four (4) round trip coach fares for the Winner and Guests between a major Canadian International airport closest to the Winner's residence (the “**Departure Airport**”) and Orlando International Airport (the “**Arrival Airport**”), as determined by the Prize Provider (with possible layovers, airport, airline carrier and flights to be selected by Prize Provider in its sole and absolute discretion);
 - (b) Up to four (4) round trip ground transfers for the Winner and Guests between the Arrival Airport and *Walt Disney World* Resort, as determined by the Prize Provider in its sole and absolute discretion;
 - (c) Five (5) consecutive nights’ hotel accommodations at *Walt Disney World* Resort in a standard room, at a hotel to be selected by the Prize Provider in its sole discretion, for the Winner and Guests, based on quadruple occupancy unless otherwise indicated;
 - (d) Up to four (4) 6-Day *Walt Disney World* Theme Park Tickets with *Park Hopper* Plus Option (the “**Tickets**”); and
 - (e) One (1) Disney Gift Card (the “**Gift Card**”) with a value of six hundred U.S. dollars (USD\$600.00) for the Winner (subject to restrictions).

- 4.2 The Prize has an approximate value of nine thousand eight hundred U.S. dollars (USD \$9,800). Actual value of Prize will depend on departure city, seasonal fluctuations of airfare and fluctuations in currency exchange rates, and the number of Guests.
- 4.3 Winner is not entitled to monetary difference between actual Prize value and stated approximate Prize value, if any.
- 4.4 Prize will be distributed within thirty (30) days after Winner has been successfully contacted and notified of their Prize and fulfilled the requirements set out herein.

5. PRIZE CONDITIONS.

- 5.1 All bookings and/or reservations are subject to hotel, room, and flight availability at time of booking through Prize Provider at least forty-five (45) days prior to arrival. Black-out dates may apply. Winner and Guests must be available to travel and participate in the Prize between January 1, 2022 and September 30, 2022, and must be able to travel together on the same itinerary. No extensions will be granted. Air transportation must be round-trip from/to the same Departure Airport to the Arrival Airport. Certain travel and lodging restrictions apply including airline carrier's regulations and conditions. Airline tickets are non-refundable, non-transferable, and are not valid for upgrades. Corus and the Prize Provider are not liable for any expenses incurred as a consequence of flight cancellation/delay. Should Winner and/or Guests be unable to travel/participate on the dates and times designated herein by Corus, the Prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner.
- 5.2 The terms by which the Gift Card may be redeemed are governed by the Prize Provider as described on the website located at: <https://www.disneygiftcard.com/ProductInformation/WhereToUse>. Corus is not responsible for administering or ensuring compliance with the terms and conditions relating to the Gift Card.
- 5.3 Winner and Guests will be responsible for transportation to and from the Departure Airport, travel and medical insurance, travel documentation, applicable airport departure fees and taxes, airport parking fees, airport improvement fees or similar charges, bag check fees, tips and gratuities, nursery charges (if applicable), meals, hotel room service, laundry service, spa treatments, beverages, local and long distance telephone calls, merchandise and souvenirs, incidental expenses and any other expense not explicitly included in the Prize. Winner may be required to present a valid major credit card upon check-in at *Walt Disney World* Resort to cover any expenses over and above the standard room charge.
- 5.4 Guests must: (i) be legally able to travel to the United States of America and have any and all necessary documentation as may be required for presentation to Canadian and/or International customs and airport personnel; and (ii) comply with the Contest Rules and sign and return the Release (described in Section 7 below).
- 5.5 The parent or guardian of any minor not travelling with their parent or guardian must appoint an adult to have custody and control over their minor and to contract on their behalf in connection with the Prize. An appointment form will be included in the document package and must be signed by parent or legal guardian prior to the travel date.
- 5.6 Prize must be accepted as awarded and cannot be sold, traded, transferred, refunded, commissioned, assigned, substituted or redeemed for cash or rescheduled to dates other than as set forth above, except at the sole discretion of Corus and the Prize Provider. If the Winner

chooses to bring less than the allotted number of Guests, the Prize will be awarded in increments suitable for the actual number of participants with no substitute Prize or compensation provided to the Winner. Any unused, unclaimed or declined portion of any Prize will be forfeited, have no cash value, and Corus and the Prize Provider shall have no obligation to provide either an alternative or value-in-kind. Any damaged, lost or stolen Tickets, Gift Cards or travel vouchers will not be replaced. Corus and the Prize Provider reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if the Prize (or any portion thereof) cannot be awarded for any reason. Theme parks, attractions and other offerings subject to availability, closures and change or cancellation without notice or liability. Park admission, offerings and Ticket options are not guaranteed. Prize Provider reserves the right to cancel any offering. Winner may not charge any Guest for participating in the Prize.

5.7 Terms and conditions as set forth herein and on the Tickets and vouchers shall apply. To enter a theme park, both a park reservation and valid Ticket for the same theme park on the same date are required. Reservations can be made using the Disney Park Pass system. Reservations are subject to availability and are not guaranteed until a reservation is finalized. A park reservation must be made for each day of entry. The *Park Hopper* Option includes same-day admission to more than one theme park on each day of the Ticket. The Winner and Guests must make a park reservation via the Disney Park Pass reservation system for the first theme park they plan to visit. After entering that first theme park, Winner and/or Guests will be able to visit the next theme park starting at 2:00 PM until each theme park's regularly scheduled closure. The ability to visit a theme park is subject to the theme park's capacity limitations. At this time, a park reservation is not required after the first theme park, however, reservation requirements are subject to the change. The *Park Hopper Plus* Option includes a certain number of visits to a water park or other *Walt Disney World* fun. Water parks subject to rehabilitation, seasonal and weather closures. To participate in NBA Experience activities, footwear is required; athletic footwear is recommended. Age restrictions may apply. Adults must sign a waiver when they arrive at the venue; for children younger than age eighteen (18), the child's parent/guardian must sign the waiver for minors. For convenience, you may view the waiver in advance at disneyworld.disney.go.com/en_CA/guest-services/experience-waivers/. Tee times are required for Disney's Oak Trail Golf Course and are subject to availability. FootGolf is available every Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday after 2:30 PM, subject to availability. Miniature golf valid for one round. Round must start prior to 4:00 PM. Only one miniature golf visit per day. ESPN Wide World of Sports admission valid only on event days; some events require an additional admission charge; there are no events on certain days; days and hours of operation of concessions, venues and attractions vary. Visit www.espnwwos.com for more information.

5.8 ***Walt Disney World Resort has taken enhanced health and safety measures. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. Before visiting, the Winner and Guests should visit disneyworld.disney.go.com/en_CA/experience-updates/ to view important information about park reopening, reservations, limitations on benefits, features, experiences and offerings, new safety measures and other information.***

5.9 Shipped Prizes shall not be insured and neither Corus, nor the Prize Provider shall assume any liability for lost, damaged or misdirected Prizes.

5.10 Winner and/or any Guest without proper citizenship documentation will be denied boarding. It is the Winner and each Guests' responsibility to check with their travel agent, government agencies, embassies or consulates prior to their vacation to ensure that they have proper citizenship documentation. Guests of all ages are strongly encouraged to obtain passports.

5.11 All disputes arising out of or relating to the Prize shall be resolved by applying the law of Florida, without regard to conflict of law rules, and shall be solely and exclusively brought in state or in federal courts within Orange County, Florida. All claims relating to the Prize shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form or class action and all such claims shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, but in no event to include any attorneys' fees.

6. WINNER SELECTION.

6.1 One (1) Winner shall be selected as follows:

- (a) On or about July 27, 2021 in Toronto, Ontario, one (1) entrant will be selected by a random draw from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. The odds of being selected as a potential winner are dependent upon the number of eligible entries received by Corus. Before being declared the Winner, the selected entrant shall be required to correctly answer, without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question to be administered during a pre-arranged telephone call or by e-mail, to comply with the Contest Rules and to sign and return the Release;
- (b) THE SELECTED ENTRANT WILL BE NOTIFIED BY E-MAIL NO LATER THAN JULY 30, 2021 AT 10:00 A.M. ET AND MUST RESPOND WITHIN FIVE (5) BUSINESS DAYS OF NOTIFICATION. Upon notification, the selected entrant must respond by telephone or e-mail (as specified in the notification) to the contact number or e-mail address provided no later than the indicated deadline set out in the Contest Rules and/or the notification. If the selected entrant does not respond accordingly, they will be disqualified and will not receive the Prize and another entrant may be selected in Corus' sole discretion until such time as an entrant satisfies the terms set out herein. Corus is not responsible for the failure for any reason whatsoever of a selected entrant to receive notification or for Corus to receive a selected entrant's response; and
- (c) If, as a result of an error relating to the entry process, drawing or any other aspect of the Contest, there are more selected entrants than contemplated in these Contest Rules, there will be a random draw amongst all eligible Prize claimants after the Contest's closing date to award the correct number of Prizes.

7. **RELEASE.** Potential Winner, any Guest who is the age of majority and/or the parent or legal guardian of any Guest who is a minor, will be required to execute a legal agreement and release ("**Release**") that confirms each potential Winner's and each Guest's: (i) eligibility for the Contest and compliance with these Contest Rules; (ii) acceptance of the Prize as offered; (iii) release of each of Corus, Prize Provider and each of their respective employees, directors, officers, suppliers, agents, sponsors, administrators, licensees, representatives, advertising, media buying and promotional agencies (collectively, the "**Releasees**") from any and all liability for any loss, harm, damages, cost or expense arising out of participation in the Contest, participation in any Contest-related activity or the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize, including but not limited to costs, injuries, losses related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation, or portrayal in a false light, or from any and all claims of third parties arising therefrom; and (iv) grant to Corus of the unrestricted right, in Corus' collective or individual discretion, to produce, reproduce, display, publish, convert, post, serve, broadcast, exhibit, distribute, adapt and otherwise use or re-use the Winner's and any Guest's name, statements, image, likeness, voice and biography, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, in connection with the Contest and the promotion and exploitation thereof. The executed Release must be returned within five (5)

business days of the date indicated on the accompanying letter of notification or the verification as the Winner or the selected entrant will be disqualified and the Prize forfeited.

- 8. INDEMNIFICATION BY ENTRANT.** By entering the Contest, each entrant releases, indemnifies and holds Releasees harmless from any and all liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person, including personal injury, death, or property damage, resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from (a) their participation in the Contest or any Contest-related activity; (b) the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize; or (c) any breach of the Contest Rules. Each entrant agrees to fully indemnify the Releasees from any and all claims made by third parties relating to the entrant's participation in the Contest, without limitation.
- 9. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.** Corus assumes no responsibility or liability for lost, late, unintelligible/illegible, falsified, damaged, misdirected or incomplete entries, notifications, responses, replies or any Release, or for any computer, online, software, telephone, hardware or technical malfunctions that may occur, including but not limited to malfunctions that may affect the transmission or non-transmission of an entry. Corus is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by website users or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest. Corus assumes no responsibility or liability in the event that the Contest cannot be conducted as planned for any reason, including reasons beyond the control of Corus, such as infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or corruption of the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Contest and/or the Contest Microsite.
- 10. CONDUCT.** By participating in the Contest, each entrant is deemed to have executed and agrees to be bound by the Contest Rules, which will be posted at the Contest Microsite throughout the Contest Period. Each entrant further agrees to be bound by the decisions of Corus, which shall be final and binding in all respects. Corus reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant found to be: (a) violating the Contest Rules; (b) tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Contest and/or the Contest Microsite or any related promotional website; (c) violating the terms of service, conditions of use and/or general rules or guidelines of any Corus property or service; and/or (d) acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass Corus or any other person. 12. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY. All intellectual property, including but not limited to trade-marks, trade names, logos, designs, promotional materials, web pages, source code, drawings, illustrations, slogans and representations is owned by Corus and/or the Prize Provider and/or their affiliates. All rights are reserved. Unauthorized copying or use of any copyrighted material or intellectual property without the express written consent of its owner is strictly prohibited.

13. TERMINATION. Corus reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to terminate the Contest, in whole or in part, and/or modify, amend or suspend the Contest, and/or the Contest Rules in any way, at any time, for any reason without prior notice.

14. LAW. These are the official Contest Rules. The Contest is subject to applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. The Contest Rules are subject to change without notice in order to comply with any applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws or the policy of any other entity having jurisdiction over Corus. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Contest Rules or the rights and obligations as between the entrant and Corus in connection with the Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of Ontario without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other jurisdiction’s laws.

15. DISCREPANCY. In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules and disclosures or other statements contained in any Contest-related materials, including but not limited to the Contest entry form, or point of sale, television, print or online advertising, the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules shall prevail, govern and control.

This Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by any social media platforms on which the Contest may have been promoted and/or publicized including but not limited to Facebook and/or Twitter. Any personal information provided in connection with the Contest is being provided to Corus and any questions, comments or complaints regarding the Contest must be directed to Corus.
